



ASSOCIATION CHAPLAIN Role & Responsibilities

The Role

The Chaplain is not required to be a ringing cleric but an advocate for ringers. This role is an appointed position and a member of the Management Committee, able to attend the meetings of that Committee and participate in the decision-making processes.

Specific Responsibilities

- Act within, and promote, the Rules and Policies of the Association, particularly (but not limited to) regarding:
 - Health & Safety, Privacy, Standard of Conduct, Safeguarding, Risk Management, Complaints and Delegation
- Provide pastoral care to the Association and its members.
- Assist with the preparation of the Annual Service, particularly around inviting clergy to officiate or preach, and to participate on the day, usually leading Intercession.
- Support liaison with the Association's President, the Lord Bishop of Chelmsford as required.
- Provide guidance to the Association officers as requested.
