Belchamp Walter's bells, silent since the 1920s, were once regularly rung for full peals, especially during the 19th century. The village had skilled ringers who performed many peals, notably five in 1885. On December 14th, four Society of Royal Cumberland Youths members—Simon Rudd, David Sparling, Paul Cammiade, and Tim Hart—will replicate an 1885 handbell peal using the Kent Treble Bob Major method, famously featured in Dorothy L Sayers' "The Nine Tailors."
