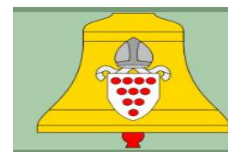

<p>Hartlebury St James – 8 Bells</p> <p>DY11 7TD</p> <p>Enter by small door to the right of the West Entrance, the toilet is just inside this door. A staircase on left to first floor Ringing Room. Some parking on driveway leading to church and the road outside.</p> 	<p>09:30am – 10:30 am</p>
<p>Rock St Peter & St Paul – 8 Bells</p> <p>DY14 9RX</p>  <p>Outside entrance is on the North-East corner of tower. Toilets in church. One Pub in village and others on the main road, Clows Top and Bewdley.</p>	<p>11:00 am – 12:00 pm</p> <p>Owing to webbing on the day we have to finish at 12.00pm</p>

<p>Kidderminster St Mary and All Saints - 12 Bells</p> <p>DY10 2JN</p>  <p>The old 24-2-22 twelve have been removed and the new installation was dedicated on 29th February 2004. A flat 6th bell was also added. Entry is by a small door to the right of the main entrance to the Church. The ringing chamber is reached via 40-50 steep spiral stairs. There is no vehicular access from the Ring Way, please approach via Churchfields. There is parking for 10 cars at the back of the church. Alternatively, a pay and display at the front of the church, which is free after 1900 and Sundays. The food at Sainbury's restaurant near the church is good and has toilet facilities. bar at the Severn Valley Railway terminal, where ringers often retire after a peal. It serves a good food and a lovely pint of Batham's too. Access to nearby town via a subway on the South side.

A wide spiral staircase having 33 steps leads to a spacious ringing room.
A very popular tourist village with narrow streets not suitable for coaches. Car Parking in church driveway. Vehicular access is via the A442 only.

The Severn Valley railway station and a public house are accessible over the foot bridge across the River Severn.
